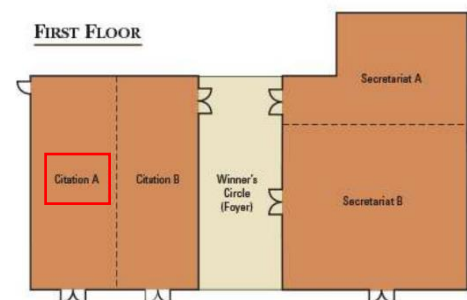
Participants in this Blue Expert Certification training camp will be able to:
